The Courses:

The Classic (*Open to all competent scullers, pairs, doubles*):-

Approximately 9000 metres from the top end of Eel Pie Island to Teddington Lock, turn at the white post and down to Richmond Lock, turn at the steps above the lock and back up to the finish at the water gallery above Hammertons Ferry. Crews will use the main navigation channel only and comply with all navigation rules.

The "Short Course" (*Open to novice and beginner singles*)

As the Classic but turning at moored boats below Glovers, avoiding the Canoe club and bridges

Approximately 7000 metres

The Megaknapps (*not for the faint-hearted*)

New this year and designed for the Draw Off, Teddington Lock to Hampton Court Bridge and back – 15000 metres on the Kingston Reach.
